

1. Trey Carrington called meeting to order at 9:01 A.M. and welcomed guest.
2. Dianna Moore read the minutes from the previous meeting. Klay Mitchell made the motion with Kasey Hibbitts seconding to approve the minutes. Motion carried 5-0.
3. Kirby Gober presented the Hospital report and bills to the court. The board approve the bills in the amount of \$342,117.88. The bills were double due to timing of meetings and there were 2 months of relief coverage for the Doctor. Trey Carrington made the motion with Greg Brockman seconding to approve and pay the hospital bills. Motion carried 5-0.
4. Citizen's Comments: Caleb Hodges reported that the Hospital decided to pick up the Meals on Wheels when the Senior Citizens closed and they will be delivering 5 days a week.

WHEREAS, Article IV, Section 7 of the Texas Constitution clearly states that the Governor of Texas

"shall be Commander-in-Chief of the military forces of the State, except when they are called into actual service of the United States. He shall have power to call forth the militia to execute the laws of the State, to suppress insurrections, and to repel invasions"; and,

WHEREAS, cartels exploit weak and unsecured borders for their own power and profit, to the detriment of our communities; and

WHEREAS, cartels act as paramilitary, narco-terrorist organizations that profit from trafficking people and drugs into the United States;

*NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Throckmorton County Commissioners Court:*


(1) recognizes our southern Texas border is suffering an invasion; and



**Re: Convey plans to add angle parking in front of Annex building**

At this time, I present information of the plans to place angle parking in front of the annex located in the 100 blk of Pogue St, Throckmorton County.

This parking will be on the North of the Throckmorton County Courthouse in front of the annex building belonging to Trent McKnight DBA The Loft at Throckmorton LLC.

I have been in contact with Mr. McKnight via text msg and have provided a copy of the text in this presentation. Mr. McKnight was to contact the City of Throckmorton to advised that he was in favor of the change as the roadway is a city street.

I inform you of the change due to need to change the flow of traffic, to a one way headed West from N. Minter. The only difference that will occur on the South Side of the street nearest the North Door of the Courthouse is parallel parking shall now face west instead of East. The traffic shall run from East to West as was the direction prior to the restoration of the courthouse.

The measurements of Pogue St are as follows:

- a. Distance across 39.7'
- b. Width of one-way lane 10'
- c. Width of area to parallel park 8' or 9'
- d. Angle parking lanes- 20.7' or 21.7' on a 30-degree angle  
The width of the spaces shall be 10'

The parking gained by angle parking shall be as follows:

- a. Two (2) Handicap parking spots located on the SW corner in front of the Sheriff's Office
- b. Five (5) regular angle parking spots from the Handicap spots on the SW corner to the already existing parallel parking handicap spot toward N. Minter.
- c. The existing parallel parking for handicap drivers near N. Minter shall not be changed and ten (10) feet shall be left open before the first parallel parking spot to ensure vehicles are able exit safely.

The difference of the one foot in the parallel parking and angle parking lanes shall be decided by the Throckmorton City Council of whom I am meeting with on 09-13-2022. As this is a city street the City Council has the final decision if they decide there is sufficient distance to accomplish these changes.

I have included a rough diagram that is not to scale to show an example of what the change may look like if the City Council decided to go forward. This will be a city project and not a Txdot operation.
