Throckmorton County Commissioners' Court met in Regular Session on Monday the 8th day of June, 2026 at 9:00 a.m., at 105 North Minter, Throckmorton, Texas, with the following members present:

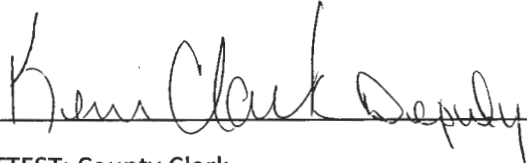
Casey Wells, Commissioner Pct. 1

Kasey Hibbitts, Commissioner Pct. 2

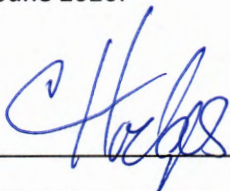
Others present: Michelle Clark, Kirby Gober, and Brad Bellah

1. Caleb Hodges called the meeting to order at 9:00 am and welcomed all guests. Commissioner Brockman and Commissioner Mitchell were absent.
2. Minutes from the previous meeting were reviewed. Casey Wells made the motion with Kasey Hibbitts seconding to approve the minutes. Motion carried 3-0.
3. Kirby Gober presented the hospital report and bills. He stated that the board approved the bills in the amount of \$257,193.42 and said it was a routine month. Kasey Hibbitts made the motion with Casey Wells seconding to approve the report and the bills. Motion carried 3-0.
4. Citizen's Comments: No comments.
5. Casey Wells made the motion with Kasey Hibbitts seconding to approve the January funding request for Year 10 Quality Incentive Payment Program IGT #19 to Texas HHSC up to \$1,081,018.00 and to finance the note through InterBank on a one year term note being due and payable on June 17, 2027, and to authorize Caleb Hodges, County Judge, to sign the promissory note and Michelle Clark, County Treasurer, to sign the security instrument on behalf of the County. Motion carried 3-0.
6. Caleb Hodges made the motion with Casey Wells seconding to Canvass the May 2026 Runoff Election. Motion carried 3-0.
7. Caleb Hodges made the motion with Kasey Hibbitts seconding to replace the exterior lights and office lights in the courthouse. Motion carried 3-0.
8. Elected Officials Report: Discussion was held about the toilet at the Community Closet. Casey stated he was wanting to get rid of a tractor because they are spending too much on fixing it and looking to upgrade a backhoe. Commissioners discussed looking possibly at an auction. Caleb stated that the homicide trial was cancelled, and a plea deal will be entered.
9. Michelle Clark presented the bills to the court. Kasey Hibbitts made the motion with Casey Wells seconding to approve and pay the bills. Motion carried 3-0.
10. No Executive Session
11. Casey Wells made the motion with Kasey Hibbitts seconding to adjourn at 9:20 a.m. Motion carried 3-0.
