Regular Meeting

Throckmorton County Commissioners' Court met in Regular Session on Monday the 14th day of July 2025 at 9:00 a.m., at 105 North Minter, Throckmorton, Texas, with the following members present:

Kasey Hibbitts, Commissioner Pct. 2
Caleb Hodges, County Judge

Greg Brockman, Commissioner Pct. 3
Dianna Moore, County Clerk

Others present: Hayley Briles, Bobby Thompson, Kirby Gober, and Bryan Key

1. Caleb Hodges called meeting to order at 9:00 A.M. and welcomed guest. Commissioner's Wells and Mitchell were absent.
2. Minutes from the previous meeting were reviewed. Kasey Hibbitts made the motion with Greg Brockman seconding to approve the minutes. Motion carried 3-0.
3. Kirby Gober presented the hospital report and bills to the court. Kirby stated the board approved the bills in the amount of \$292,892.55 and that it was a routine month. Bryan Key addressed the court regarding not having access to the Nursing Home funds at this time and the concern about needing funds. Bryan also stated that at the next meeting he would be applying for a new IGT payment. Kasey Hibbitts made the motion with Greg Brockman seconding to approve the report and pay the bills. Motion carried 3-0.
4. Citizen's Comments: no comments were made.
5. Caleb Hodges made the motion with Greg Brockman seconding to approve the Court Reporter's salary for 2026. Motion carried 3-0.
6. Greg Brockman made the motion with Kasey Hibbitts seconding to approve the 2026 Sheriff's Service Fees with no changes. Motion carried 3-0.
7. Kasey Hibbitts made the motion with Greg Brockman seconding to enter an Inter Local Agreement with the Regional Public Defender for Capital Murder. Motion carried 3-0.
8. Kasey Hibbitts made the motion with Greg Brockman seconding to purchase a new radar for the Sheriff's 2020 Dodge Ram using SB22 Funds and if there is any overage, the county will pay the remaining out of line item 750. Motion carried 3-0.
9. Elected Officials Report: Greg Brockman stated that Brad Bellah notified him about a presentation on screw worms at the Youth Center on July 21, 2025 at 7pm. Caleb Hodges discussed the issues of employee drug testing and talked about using Quest Lab in Abilene. He also stated that Klay Mitchell was home from surgery and that Dianna Moore will be out for several weeks due to having surgery next week. Bobby Thompson stated that the tire shop here closed.
10. Hayley Briles presented the bills to the court. Caleb Hodges made the motion with Kasey Hibbitts seconding to pay the bills. Motion carried 3-0.

12. Caleb Hodges made the motion and seconded by Kasey Hibbitts to adjourn at 9:25 a.m. Motion carried 3-0.
