Throckmorton County Commissioners' Court met in Regular Session on Monday the 9th day of March 2026 at 9:00 a.m., at 105 North Minter, Throckmorton, Texas, with the following members present:




Others present: Michelle Clark and Kirby Gober

1. Caleb Hodges called the meeting to order at 9:00 am and welcomed all guest. Commissioner Wells was absent.
2. Minutes from the previous meeting were reviewed. Klay Mitchell made the motion with Greg Brockman seconding to approve the minutes. Motion carried 4-0.
3. Kirby Gober presented the Hospital bills and report to the court. Kirby stated the hospital board approved the bills in the amount of \$378,884.02 and that \$187,000.00 of that was having to be paid back for the HHSC, DY11 for 2022, which was an overpayment on UC expenses. The board requested \$150,000.00 from the subsidy and Kirby stated that they will probably need more money from the county this year. Klay Mitchell made the motion with Greg Brockman seconding to approve the report and pay the bills. Motion carried 4-0.
4. Citizen's Comments: No comments.
5. Caleb Hodges made the motion with Greg Brockman seconding to approve the purchase of a Caterpillar 2015 Maintainer from Breckenridge for \$110,000.00, minus the trade in value with Caleb Hodges and Greg Brockman to discuss the payment line item in the coming years. Motion carried 4-0.
6. Klay Mitchell made the motion with Kasey Hibbitts seconding to renew the RAVE Emergency Alert System for the County and to pay one year. Motion carried 4-0.
7. Klay Mitchell made the motion with Greg Brockman seconding to allow up to \$200,000.00 to preapprove to pay to the hospital only if emergency funds are needed. Motion carried 4-0.
8. Elected Officials Report: Kasey Hibbitts stated that he is looking at a maintainer to purchase. Klay Mitchell stated that he had to let an employee go and that he is going to hire a part time employee at this time.
9. Michelle Clark presented the bills to the court. Caleb Hodges made the motion with Klay Mitchell seconding to pay the bills. Motion carried 4-0.
10. No Executive Session
11. Greg Brockman made the motion with Kasey Hibbitts seconding to adjourn at 9:42 a.m. Motion carried 4-0.
