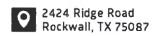

Property Location

Inertia Wind Project, LLC is to be located in western Throckmorton County and Throckmorton Independent School District. Please find attached in Exhibit 2 & Exhibit 3 maps detailing the specific site.

Description of Project:

The Project is a 298.6 MW AC wind energy generation facility that will be located across Haskell and Throckmorton County. In its entirety, the facility will be comprised of approximately 108 GE model turbines. ECONOMIC OVERVIEW

Employment Impact:

During the construction phase of this Project there will be an estimated 200 – 300 construction employees. Upon completion of construction, there will be 1 full time employee responsible for the operation and maintenance of the Project. The full-time employee will be compensated annually with at least 110% of the West Central Texas Council of Government average manufacturing weekly wage of \$49,946.60 in addition to full health benefits.

Fiscal Impact:

The total investment anticipated for the Project (within Throckmorton County specifically) will be \$84,000,000. For a more detailed description of this project's value and tax benefit for Throckmorton County, please refer to Exhibit 1.

External Impacts:

The establishment of Inertia Wind Project, LLC will benefit existing businesses and facilities throughout Throckmorton County. During the construction phase, employees will need to utilize local establishments for dining and lodging requirements. Once construction is complete, there will be 1 full-time employee required for the operation and maintenance of the facility. In the case of wind generation facilities, the individuals hired for these positions are often members of the local community. Renewable energy development provides positive fiscal impacts for local communities through not only increased property tax revenue, but job creation and economic opportunities for local vendors. Like other forms of renewable energy, wind energy has very minimal (nearly zero) environmental impacts.

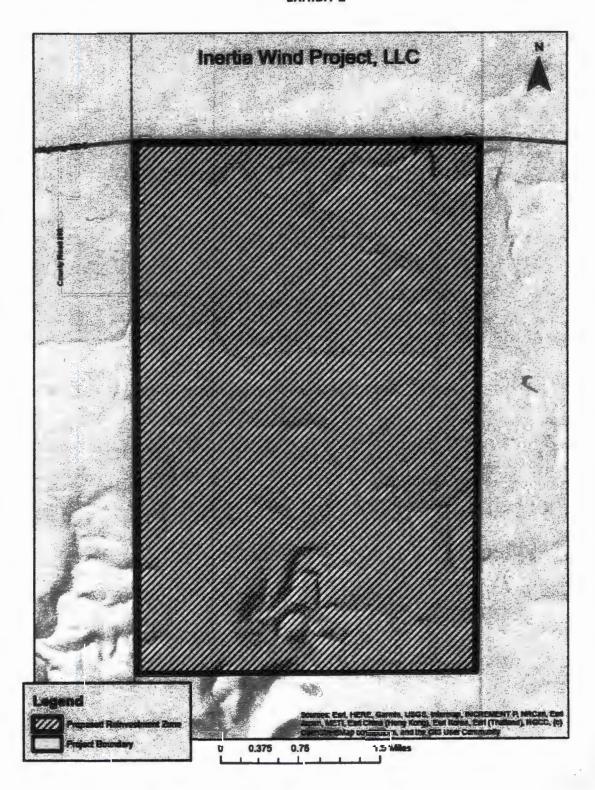
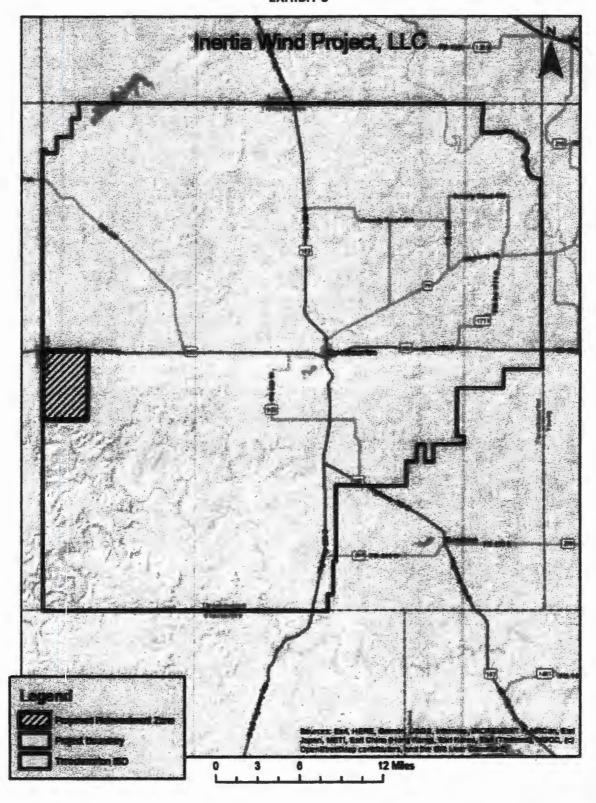

This letter submitted herewith for your consideration is the proposed budget of Throckmorton County for the fiscal year January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022. This budget for a county with an estimated population of 1,440 people anticipates total funds available of \$2,563,950.00 and total disbursements of \$2,496,049.00. These figures represent an increase of 1.14% in available funds and an increase of 1.46% in disbursements when compared to the original 2021 budget. Approximately 70.1% of the receipts will be realized through a proposed ad valorem tax of \$0.996574/100 of assessed valuation, which is \$0.090346/100 higher than last years tax rate of \$0.906228/100. The remainder of the receipts will come from other local sources and various state payments.

More detailed information of the proposed budget, including comparisons with previous years will be found in the schedules that follow.

This budget was prepared as requested by the Commissioner's Court. I will be pleased to answer any questions that you might have.

State Criminal Justice Mandate

The THROCKMORTON COUNTY Auditor certifies that THROCKMORTON COUNTY has spent \$38,325 in the previous 12 months for the maintenance and operations cost of keeping inmates sentenced to the Texas Department of Criminal Justice. THROCKMORTON COUNTY Sheriff has provided THROCKMORTON COUNTY information on these costs, minus the state revenues received for reimbursement of such costs. This increased the no-new-revenue tax rate by \$0.010656/\$100.

Indigent Health Care Compensation Expenditures

THROCKMORTON COUNTY spent \$13,827 from July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021 on indigent health care compensation expenditures at the increased minimum eligibility standards, less the amount of state assistance. For the current tax year, the amount of increase above last year's enhanced indigent health care expenditures is \$13,361. This increased the no-new-revenue tax rate by \$0.007405/\$100.
